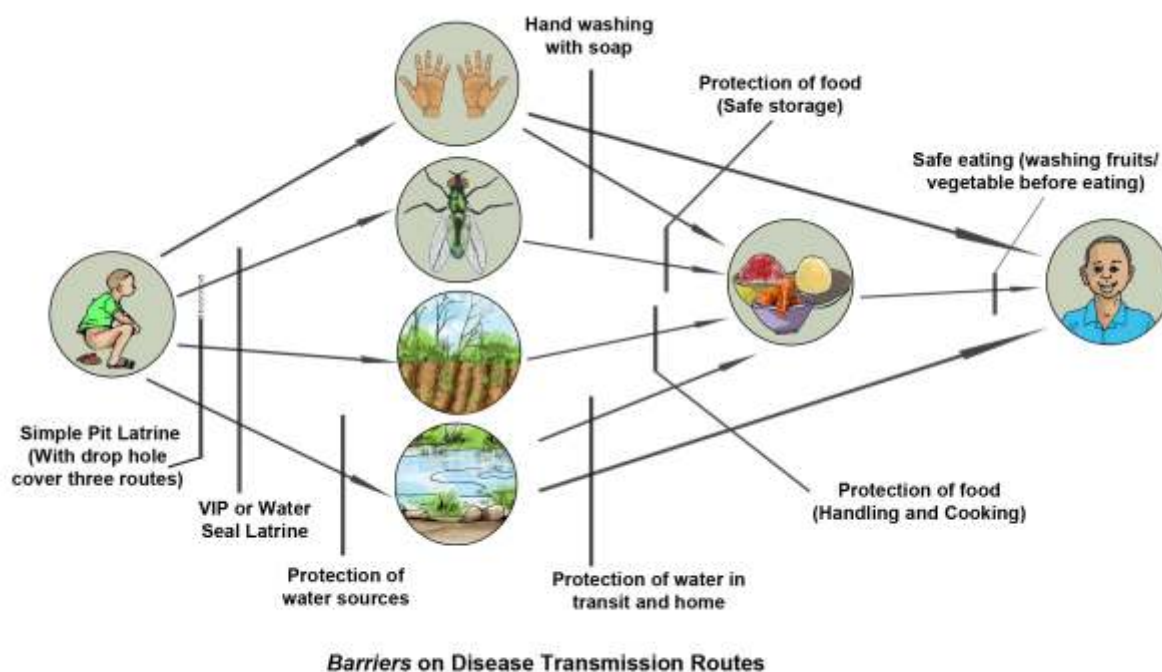
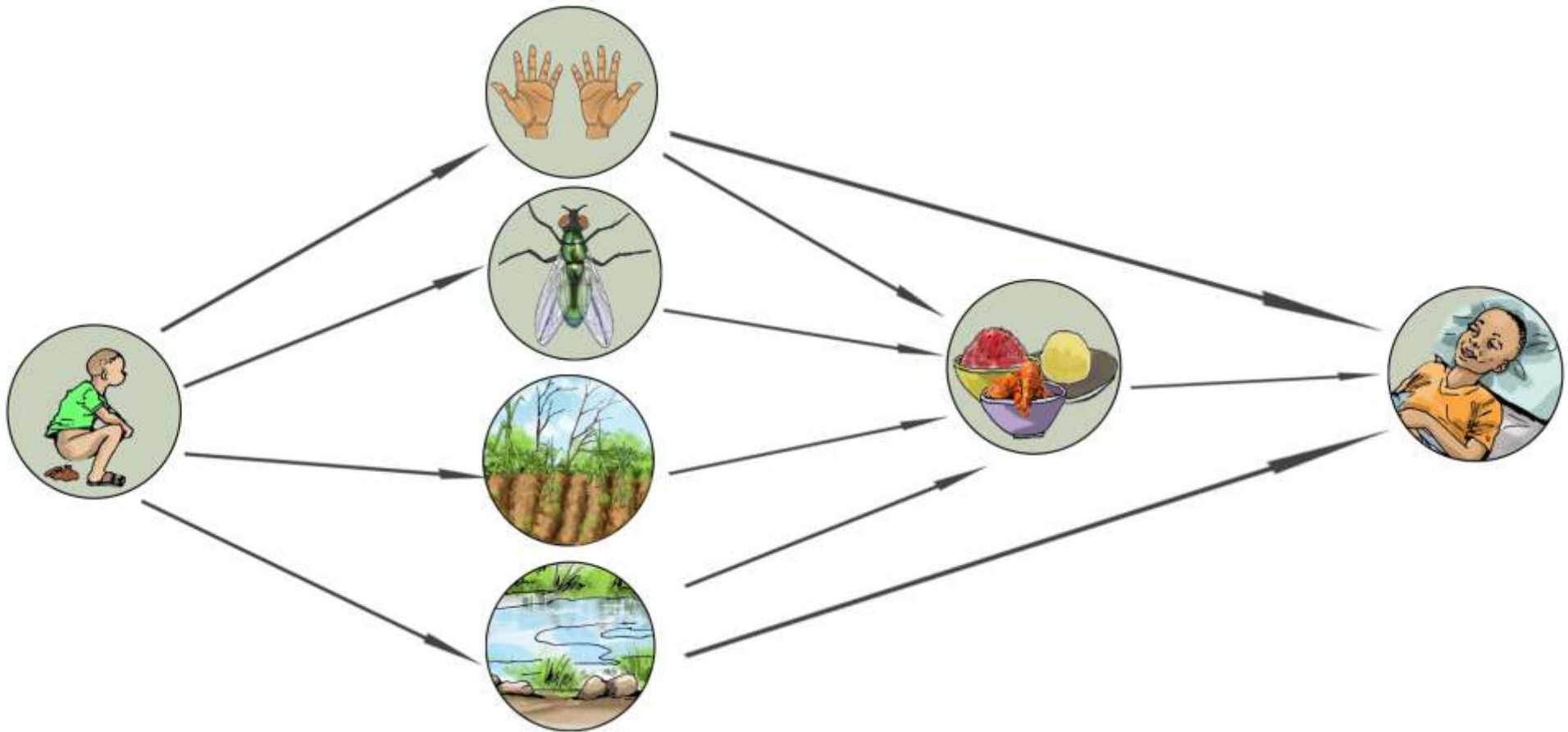




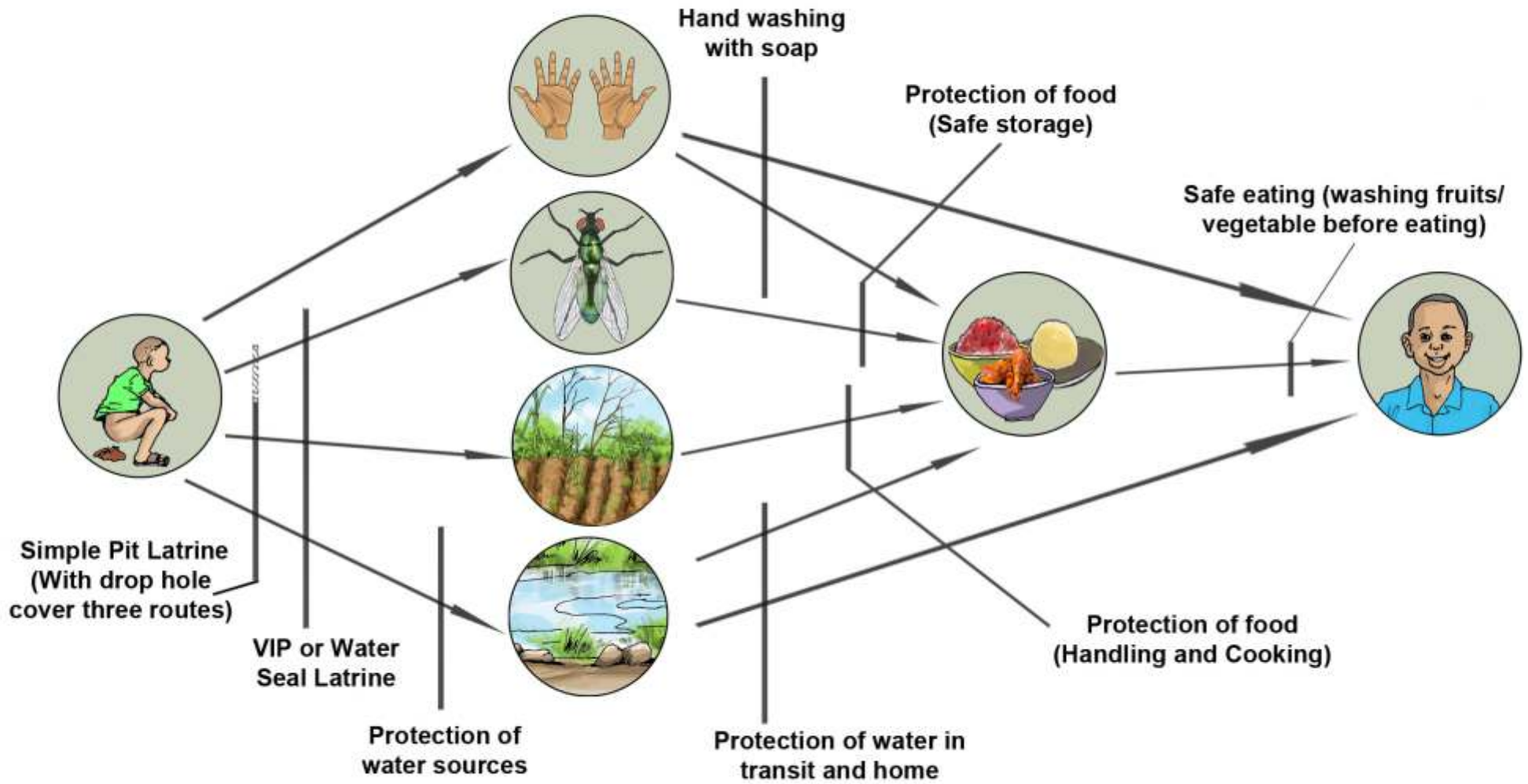

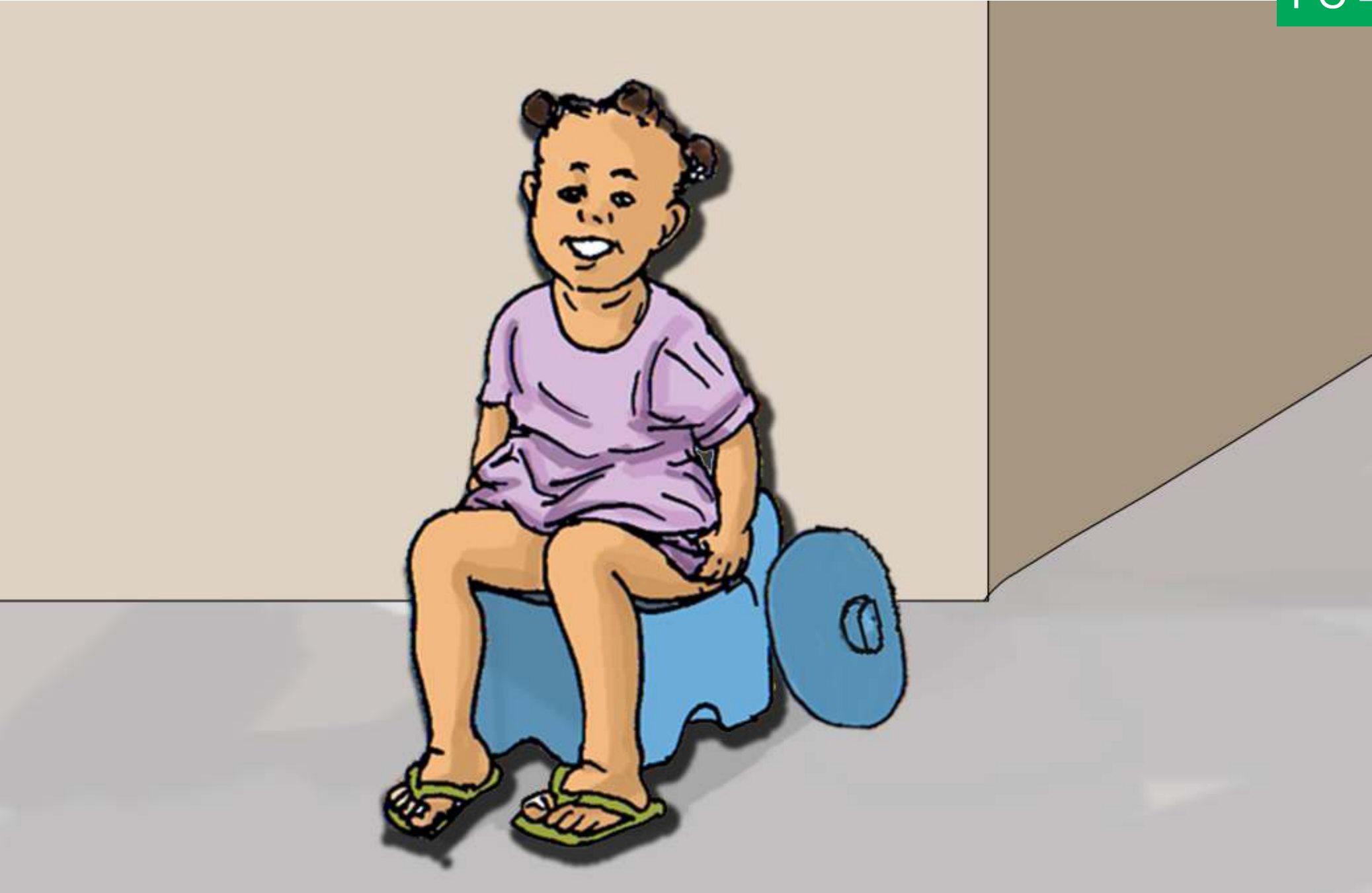

EFFECTIVE HAND WASHING STEP BY STEP GUIDE



(1) Wet hands under running water.



(2) Apply soap and rub palms together to ensure complete coverage.



(3) Spread the lather over the back of the hands.



(4) Make sure the soap gets in between the fingers.



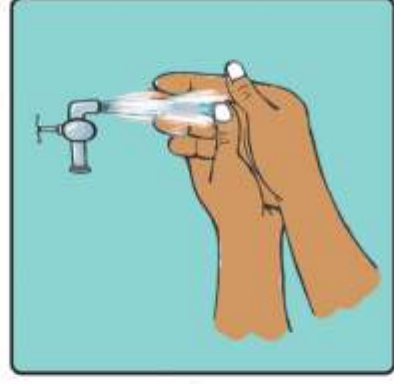
(5) Grip the fingers on each other.



(6) Pay particular attention to the thumb.



(7) Press fingertips into the palm of each hand.



(8) Rinse hands thoroughly with clean water.



(9) Wring hands to dry.

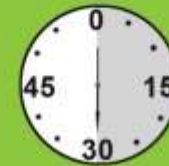

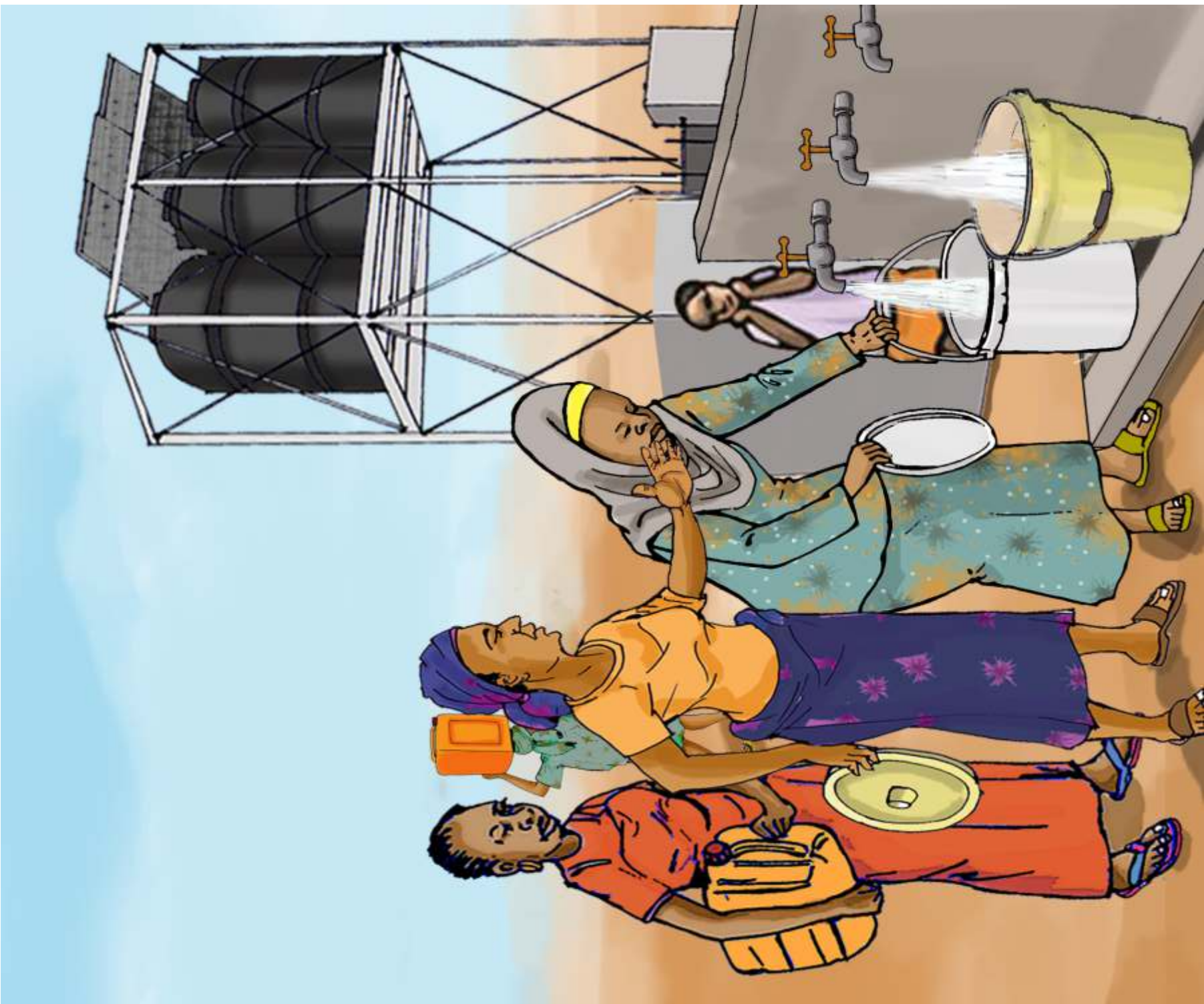

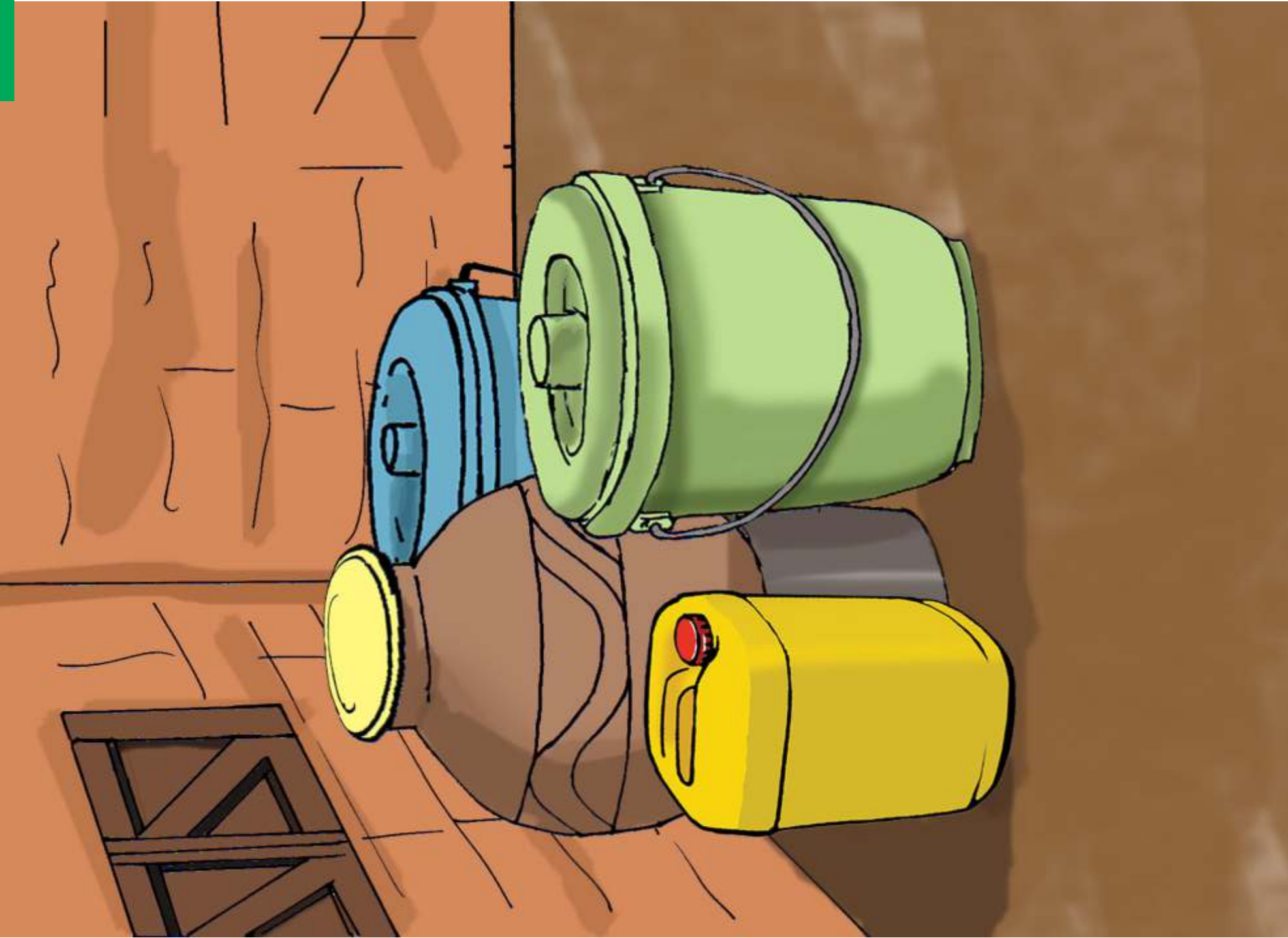

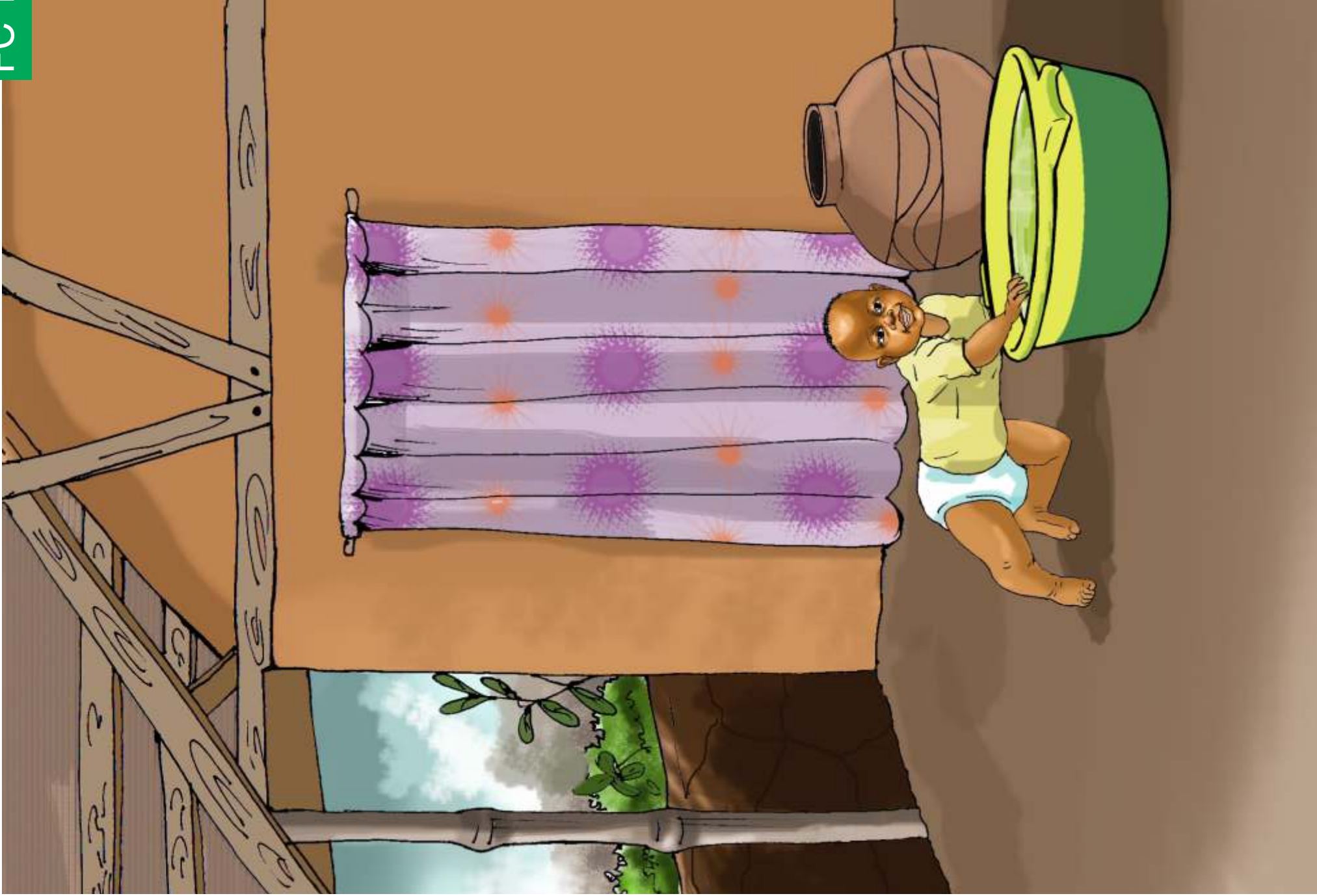
